Rules for M.Sc. Admissions for the Academic Year 2025-26.

1) Admission Eligibility Criteria:

2) Merit Calculation:

1. For Merit preparation marks obtained at semester 5 & 6 External Examination will be considered. **Students having their mark sheet with CGPA have to convert CGPA into Percentage from their parent University/Institute, else the university will convert CGPA into percentage by its own and student has to accept.**
2. In case of similar merit, The merit will be calculated up to three decimal places. If two or more candidates still have the same merit, admission will be granted based on the total percentage of marks obtained in the 5th & 6th semester/third-year degree examination. If merit still remain identical, merit shall be prepared considering the Aggregate of the Semester III & IV/ second year.
3. Candidates applying under the Sports Quota must submit a certificate of participation at national-level sports competition. There shall be one seat reserved per 30 seats in a course and the seat shall be allotted in the respective category of the candidate. maximum two seats can be reserved per subject.

Note: If a candidate continued their studies in the same year after B.Sc., no marks will be deducted. Valid supporting documents must be submitted.

3) Seat Allocation:

1. **90% of seats** will be allocated to students from Hemchandracharya North Gujarat University.
2. **5% of seats** will be allocated to students from other universities within Gujarat.
 - If seats remain vacant from category 1, they will be allocated to category 2 based on merit without considering the category.
3. **5% of seats** will be reserved for out-of-state candidates. **However, if there are no applications from such candidates, these seats will be allocated to the parent university candidates.**

4) Reserved Category Seats:

(A) Seats will be reserved for candidates who are permanent residents of Gujarat, as per the prevailing government regulations:

5	Children of Ex-Servicemen(In the respective category of applicant)	1%

6	(A)Physically Challenged (PC) (In the respective category of applicant)	5%
	(B) Blind/Low Vision Candidates (In the respective category of applicant)	1%
7	Widow (In the respective category of applicant)	1%
8	Current/Ex-Army men (In the respective category of applicant)	1%

Additional Rules for Reserved Categories:

1. If SC, ST, or OBC candidates qualify in General Merit, they will be considered under both the General and their respective reserved category. However, if they opt for admission under General Merit, they will not be counted in their reserved category seat allocation.
2. If SC category seats remain vacant, they will be allocated to ST candidates and vice versa. If no candidates from SC/ST are available for admission, the seats shall be allocated to general category candidates.
3. Candidates applying under any reserved category must submit a valid certificate issued by a competent authority; otherwise, they will be considered under General category.
4. OBC candidates must submit caste and also submit "Non-Creamy Layer" Certificate issued by a competent authority. The certificate must be issued after 1st April of respective year mentioning the validity of the same for three years or issued after 1st April of the respective academic year. Otherwise, they will be considered under General category.
5. Widowed applicant must submit their Husband's death certificate and an affidavit obtained before a First-Class Magistrate stating that she has not remarried.
6. Applicants under EWS category has to submit an income certificate issued by the respective competent Authority.
7. Candidates who are children of current or ex-servicemen from the central governments armed and paramilitary forces as well as Gujarat State's defense forces, has to submit a latest certificate from the District Soldier Welfare Board, duly signed by a competent authority. Other wise they will be considered under General Category.

Note : This is a full-time course. Students cannot engage in employment or enroll in any other degree course while pursuing this program. Violation of this rule will result in legal action.

5) Fee Refund Policy:

The fee refund will be processed as per the **prevailing university regulations effective from time to time.**

Note: The **Vice-Chancellor's decision will be final** in matters of interpretation and changes to these admission rules.
