2. INTRODUCTION

About College:

The School of Nursing, Vadodara was started in 1925 at Shree Sayajirao Gaykawad Hospital (SSGH) campus with Diploma in General Nursing Course. In 2008, the School of Nursing was upgraded into Government College of Nursing, Vadodara (GCONV) with introduction of Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc. Nursing) course. Now Master of Science in Nursing (M.Sc. Nursing) course is started from November, 2023. This college has completed 98 years of teaching to nursing students. The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda affiliated both graduate (B.Sc. Nursing) and post graduate (M.Sc. Nursing) programmes in nursing are also recognized by Gujarat Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council.

The programme is based on sound educational principles which make provision for continuous development of the student as an individual, a citizen and a professional nurse. The college aims at providing desirable behavioral changes in the students which are brought about by meaningful experiences within a climate of mutual respect and understanding. The course in the physical and biological sciences helps them to understand the scientific principles of nursing. The study of social and behavioral sciences helps them to understand their clients with varied socio-economic and cultural background.

3. PHILOSOPHY, VISION & MISSION :

4. CORE VALUES

Autonomy is about power and control over nursing practice. Greater autonomy for nurses improves patient care, patient satisfaction and elevates the status of the profession.

b) Accountability:

Accountability is an inherent confidence as a professional that allows a nurse to take pride in being transparent about the way he or she has carried out their practice. Nurses are personally accountable for their actions and therefore place the emphasis on the development and demonstration of competence in practice.

c) Compassion:

Compassion refers to being close to patients and seeing their situation as more than a

medical scenario and routine procedure. In nursing, it is the fundamental element of nursing care and reflects the strength of the profession.

d) Discipline:

Discipline is course of action leading to a greater goal than the satisfaction of the immediate. Discipline in nursing helps in imparting systematic and standardized care and to develop sense of honor leading to self actualization and self esteem.

e) Diversity:

Diversity is being aware of similarities and differences among the diverse client-care populations in the areas of health and illness. In nursing practice, it is imperative that nurses understand concepts such as culture and multiculturalism and their influence on health and health perceptions, while providing healthcare for the individual as well as the community.

f) Human Dignity:

Human dignity is respect for the inherent worth and uniqueness of individuals and populations. In nursing practice, concern for human dignity is reflected when the nurse values and respects all patients, colleagues and other health team members.

g) Integrity:

Integrity is an understanding and knowing oneself entirely and completely (physically, mentally, spiritually and emotionally). Nursing professionals need to know and relate to others in a holistic manner; which will serve as the basis for providing quality nursing care by being respectful, honest, ethical and morally justified.

5. OBJECTIVES OF M. Sc. NURSING

The Master program prepares the graduate to:

- a. utilize/apply the concepts, theories and principles of nursing science
- b. demonstrate advance competence in practice of nursing
- c. practice as a nurse specialist.
- d. demonstrate leadership qualities and function effectively as nurse educator and manager.
- e. demonstrate skill in conducting nursing research, interpreting and utilizing the findings from health related research

- f. demonstrate the ability to plan and effect change in nursing practice and in the health care delivery system.
- g. establish collaborative relationship with members of other disciplines
- h. demonstrate interest in continued learning for personal and professional advancement.

6. DETAILS ABOUT THE COURSE OF STUDY: M. Sc. NURSING (2 Years)

6.1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- a. The candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
- b. Minimum educational requirements shall be the passing of: Basic B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Hons. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- c. The candidate should have undergone Basic B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Hons. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
- d. Minimum one year of work experience after course completion of Basic B.Sc. Nursing
- e. The candidates qualifying P. B. B.Sc.(N) from IGNOU through distance education is not eligible for M.Sc.(N) programme if the study centers are not recognized by INC.
- f. Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B. Sc. Nursing.
- g. Candidate shall be medically fit.
- h. 5% relaxation of marks for SC/ST candidates may be given.
- i. Candidates with 40 % -50% of lower extremity disability are eligible to apply.

6.2 ADMISSION PROCEDURE

6.2. 1. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM AND APPEARING THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION: -

- Before applying, candidates are advised to go through the admission instructions given therein carefully and then fill in the application form and submit the required documents mentioned in the application form.
- Candidates need to apply only through GCAS Portal.
- Course details and Application Form for M. Sc. Nursing available on: GCAS Portal
- The candidates belong to Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes/OBC/ EWS are required to furnish a valid certificate from the Mamlatdar.

- No request for a change in category (General, SC, ST, OBC and EWS) applied for is entertained after the submission of the application.
- Applicants who have not studied under MS University, Vadodara needs to furnish the migration certificate from the university which they have passed their last examination at the time of their joining along with all other certificates in original in support of their qualifications.
- If a candidate is found to have furnished false information or certificate or concealed some information in her application, her candidature for examination/ admission will be cancelled.
- If ineligibility of a candidate is detected at any stage, her candidature for admission will be cancelled.
- Rules are subject to change in accordance with decision of the Institute, INC, GNC, University and Gujarat Government notifications taken from time to time.
- Any dispute in regard to any matter referred to herein shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Vadodara Court alone

For In-Service Candidates (M. Sc. Nursing Course)

- The applications of in-service candidates for M. Sc. (N) must be accompanied with **No Objection Certificate (NOC)** from the Head of the Institute / Employer. (In case delay is anticipated in obtaining the NOC, the same can be submitted at the time of counseling). Otherwise the admission shall be rejected without any correspondence in this regard.

6.3.1. ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

The seats will be filled strictly based on the marks secured in the entrance examination.

1. The entrance examination will be conducted by MSU, Vadodara
2. Entrance Examination will be in English language only.
3. Allocation of specialty in M. Sc. Nursing will be strictly based on the marks secured in the entrance examination conducted by MSU, Vadodara.
4. No TA/ DA will be paid for attending the Entrance Examination and Counseling.

6.4 COUNSELING AND ADMISSION DETAILS:

As per MSU, Vadodara

❖ Admission

- Candidates would be admitted on the day of counseling.
- Selected candidates need to pay the fees and submit their original documents on the day of admission, failing which her selection will be treated as cancelled and seat will be offered to the next candidate on the merit/waiting list.
- Any attempt on the part of candidate to influence the management directly or indirectly will be treated as unfair means and candidate will be disqualified.
- The decision of the Admission Committee of MSU in the matter of selection of candidate(s) for the course/clinical specialty shall be the final.
- In case of any disput, the decision of Grievance Redressal Committee shall be final.
- No individual intimation will be sent to the non selected candidates.

❖ Joining Time

Selected candidates must join the course on the stipulated date instructed by MSU, Vadodara during counseling. No extension in joining shall be granted. **The admission of selected candidates who fail to join by the stipulated date shall automatically stand cancelled and no correspondence will be entertained.** The institute takes no responsibility of intimating for cancellation of seats.

❖ Medical Examination

Medical fitness will be pre-condition for admission for all candidates. The candidates will be also medically examined by a Medical Board, constituted by the Institute to determine their medical fitness. (Annexure 1)

➤ **Candidates with 40%-50% of lower extremity disability need to submit the disability certificate along with the application form.**

- I. A disability certificate duly constituted and authorized by the Medical Board of the State or Central Govt. Hospitals / Institutions need to be uploaded along with the online application form and has to be produced before the Certificate Verification Committee.
- II. He/She should also appear before an Institutional Medical Board and obtain a valid Disability Certificate prior to admission.

- III. The suitability of the candidate against her disability will be assessed against the patient safety norms for due certification by the Medical Board.
- IV. The decision of the Institutional Medical Board is final in this regard.
- V. Candidates shall be medically fit. However, Colour Blind candidates should be considered for admission to Nursing Courses subject to the condition that Colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.

6.6. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES AND SUBMISSION OF UNDERTAKING

- The applicants selected for post graduate course shall have to submit an undertaking on Rs.50/- stamp paper at the time of joining the course to the effect that he/she shall not discontinue the M.Sc Nursing course she has been allotted to after the validity period of the rank list. M.Sc Nursing student who discontinues the course after the validity period of the select list, he/she shall pay Rs. 0.5 Lakh/- as liquidated damages and also repay the scholarship / stipend already received if any.

6.7 ALLOCATION OF SEATS FOR M.Sc. NURSING COURSE as per the Reservation Roster Points :-

The affiliated PG Institutes/ Colleges will prepare separately the category wise seat list in each degree subject. The 7% of seats available for PG Degree will be reserved for candidates belonging to Schedules Cast, 15% of seats will be similarly reserved for ST candidates, 27% of seats will be similarly reserved for candidates belonging to Socially and Educationally Backward Class (SEBC) students including widows and orphan children and 10% of seats will be similarly reserved for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) provided that the reservation of seats for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) shall be applicable only to those colleges or institutes, where the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare/ Government and concerned

Council have increased the number of seats to implement the 10% EWS reservation quota. The student desiring admission under SEBC category will have to submit a non-creamy layer certificate of financial year pertaining to the period of application that they are not included in the creamy layer from the competent authority as prescribed by the Govt. of Gujarat from time to time along with the application. The students desiring admission under EWS category will have to submit a EWS Certificate issued by competent authority along with the application as per the rules and regulations prescribed from time to time by Govt. of Gujarat.

6.8 INSTRUCTIONS FOR JOINING THE COURSE

1. The duration of training is 2 years, strictly full time and ordinarily continuous.
2. The admission is **provisional**, subject to the issuing of Final Eligibility certificate by MS University, Vadodara.
3. The selected candidates will have to submit the Original **documents/certificates** mentioned at 6.2.2.
4. The rules are subject to change in accordance with the decision of the university and Government of Gujarat from time to time.
5. Any attempt on the part of candidate to influence the management directly or indirectly will be treated as unfair means and candidate will be disqualified.
6. The decision of the MSU/ SNRC/ INC/ Govt. of Gujarat in the matter of the course shall be the final at any point of time during entire programme..

N. B.:

1. Minimum pass marks shall be 50 % in each of the Theory and practical papers separately.
2. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each subject for appearing for examination.
3. A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of degree.
4. A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.
5. If a candidate fails in either theory or practical paper he/she has to re-appear for both the papers (Theory and practical).
6. Maximum number of attempts permitted for each paper is 3 including first attempt.
7. The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 4 (four) years
8. No candidate shall be admitted to the subsequent 2nd year examination unless the candidate has passed the 1st year examination.

8. FACILITIES OF THE COLLEGE

College has its own a parent hospital with 1531 bedded Shri Sayaji Rao General Hospital (SSGH), Vadodara, to enable the nursing students to acquire knowledge through clinical experience. Students are also posted in rural and urban health centers for their community field experience as well as at Hospital for Mental Health, Vadodara for experience in Mental Health.

The college has an excellent infrastructure with state of art laboratories and mannequins for initiating teaching by simulation method furnished with the latest and best available Audio Visual teaching aids such as OHP's, LCD's, Visualizer's etc. for providing teaching and learning by interactive lecturing method well supported by experienced teaching faculty with a wide range of expertise in clinical, academics and social settings.

The institution imparts not only academic knowledge but also ensures—all-round development of the students through its best practices.

Ragging free environment

- ❖ As per the **University Grants Commission Act, 1956, Ragging is strictly prohibited inside the campus** and Anti Ragging Affidavit (Annexure -3) will be taken once admission is confirmed.

Library

- ❖ A well furnished spacious library with adequate number of books and journals with all the modern facilities is available for the students within the campus.

Hostel

- ❖ Well furnished hostel and mess facilities are provided for the students within the campus.

Uniform

- ❖ A distinct dress code for the students, with a sole objective to instill a sense of uniformity and also to inculcate the culture and values in them.

Sports and fitness facilities

- ❖ For all round development of the students liberal arrangements have been made for indoor and outdoor games and sports facilities so as to provide them with ample competitive and recreational opportunities.
- ❖ It provides them ample opportunities for recreations and extracurricular activities after the study hour.
- ❖ Students are permitted for participating in various sports events at the institutional, inter collegiate or inter university, state or national level.

Counseling and Guidance

- ❖ Counseling for a better adjustment to life is provided by the expert counselors and teachers which helps the students to solve the problems arising out of academic and non-academic challenges.
- ❖ Career guidance services are arranged to assist students on a vast spectrum of subjects relating to career planning, employment prospects, career choices and job search.
- ❖ Counseling is also provided to help the students in maintaining a healthy mind and cordial relationship among themselves. Services of trained and experienced clinical psychologists are made available to any student who needs guidance at any time.

Security services

- ❖ The college engages 24x7 high –end security service for the safety and security of students.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS:

1. Regular and punctual attendance in all class activities like lectures, demonstrations, practical's, clinical teaching, tests etc. is compulsory. Regular college time is 8:00 am – 4:00 pm or 9:00 pm – 5:00 pm. Students should participate in all college activities like clinical meetings, conferences, guest lectures, seminars as well as sports and cultural activities etc.
2. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance in theory and practical, in each subject for appearing in examination.
3. A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas.
4. As per the University, INC and GNC regulations, no student shall be allowed to appear in the annual examination of the concerned subject if her theory and practical attendance is less than 80% of the total sessions.
5. Permission for leave or absence from the classes must be taken from the class coordinator and principal.
6. In case of illness, permission shall have to be obtained from the Principal to remain absent from studies.
7. The students should not be absent / take leave without prior permission from the Principal. Any unauthorized absence will be viewed seriously and liable for punishment.
8. If the student is absent for continuous period of five days, the information regarding the leave will be intimated to the guardians/ parents.
9. If the student is unable to return on time after vacation due to illness, it is mandatory to submit the Medical Certificate from the Government hospital.
10. If a student is in need to leave the college or hospital in the middle of a day, for any emergency, she should get sanction from the class coordinator and Principal. A letter to that effect must be produced from the parent or guardian.

ACADEMIC STANDARDS

1. Students should attend all tests and show good academic progress.
2. Regularity in writing tests and satisfactory performance of students in tests are essential for permitting the students to appear for the university examination at the end of the academic year.
3. Besides the curricular activities, the students are expected to participate in all extracurricular activities such as sports and cultural programmes.

DISCIPLINE OF THE STUDENTS

1. Identity Card is mandatory during College Hours and Clinical posting.
2. Rules and regulations in relation to student's discipline will be enforced effectively to maintain discipline and to keep up the decorum of the College.
3. Students should abide by the rules and regulations of the College, Hostel and Hospital strictly.
4. Ragging or any other form of indiscipline will invite strict disciplinary action from the management.
5. For any kind of misbehavior by a student or group of students with staff or creating disturbances in Classroom /College / Hostel/ Hospital premises, strict disciplinary action will be taken. A student expelled on disciplinary grounds will not be readmitted to this college.
6. Students are not allowed to use mobile phones during college /clinical hours.
7. If any student found in use of liquor or narcotics on hospital duty or in institute premises, she will be suspended from the institute for a specific period or be expelled from the institution.
8. Possession of weapons, explosives and other objectionable material in Institute/hostel will result in being expelled from the institution.
9. Breakage of the articles in the laboratory by the student(s) will be replaced by her/them.
10. Taking active part in politics will result in being expelled from the institution.
11. Involving in group discussions/ Sharing posts/ literature promoting social /communal hatred on social media platforms will result in strict disciplinary action.
12. Student reporting for hospital duty or entering the institute premises in a scruffy appearance is liable for punishment.
13. Ragging is an offense and is strictly prohibited in the college / hostel premises. Any student(s) involved in such activities will be immediately expelled from the institution. Both junior and senior students are required to maintain cordial relationship with each other and a disciplined atmosphere in the college campus.
14. Students shall be answerable for bringing any friends/ relatives etc. to the college during regular classes, functions etc. without the permission of the concerned authorities.




